

Important information to remember before taking your DMV Permit Test

Number of Feet

- 15': No parking 15ft from a fire hydrant.
- . 100': Signal at least 100 ft before turning.
- 200': It's allowed to merge into a bike lane without a bicycle in it 200 ft before the turning light.
- 200': It's allowed to merge into a yellow center lane which is solid on the outside and broken on the inside (beginning or ending left turn lane).
- 300': Dim your high beam lights to low beam lights when approaching a car from behind.
- 500': Dim your high beam lights to low beam lights when approaching a car coming from the opposite direction.

About Number of Days

- 5 Days: Report to DMV the sale of your car.
- . 10 Days: Report to DMV a change of address.
- 10 Days: Report to DMV, if you are involved in an accident with over \$1000 in damage.

About Number of Seconds

- 3 Sec. Rule: Proper following distance between your car and the car ahead.
- 5 Sec.: Signal at least 5 seconds before changing lanes on the freeway.
- 8-12 Sec.: Average time it takes to pass another driver on the freeway.
- 10-15 Sec: Look ahead to avoid last minute moves by other drivers.

About Speed Limits

- 15 mph: Alleys, parking lots, or if the words "blind" or "can't see" appear in the questions.
- · 25 mph: School, construction, residential, and business.
- . 65 mph: Freeway unless otherwise posted.

About Blood Alcohol Concentration

- 0.01% if the driver is under 21.
- 0.08% if the driver is over 21.

About Color Curb Markings

- · Red: No parking (except for buses).
- · Green: Limited time parking.
- · Yellow: Loading or unloading only.
- Blue: Parking for handicapped with plates or placards.



The DMV standards have changed quite a bit over the years. Don't wait for the DMV to be after you before updating your driving skills.
